Please Note:

Tickets will NOT be mailed out. Also a reminder that anyone attending the performance must have a ticket regardless of age. Tickets are non-refundable.

Performance Tickets will be on sale for current students and parents to purchase starting Monday May 1st online or at our Kent Studio Office.

There is a limited time that tickets will be available to students and parents only before all tickets will open to the general public. Please purchase early to ensure your seat for the performance you wish to see.

How to order:

Purchase Tickets Online from your student portal.

Once logged on go to the tab “Payments and Purchases”. In our products section will be tickets for each performance (Cast A, Cast B, Cast C, Cast D, Cast F).

Choose the Performance you want and enter the quantity you wish to purchase and pay normally.

Physical tickets for online purchases will be available to pick up at the Kent Studio Office through June 12th. Online purchases after June 12th will be held at the theatre Will Call, available to be picked up during theatre rehearsals or the day of performance.

Tickets are General Admission and cannot be replaced, so please keep in a safe place until performance time.

Purchase Tickets at our Kent Studio Office.

During normal office hours tickets will be available for all performances to purchase where you will receive tickets immediately. Tickets are General Admission and cannot be replaced so please keep in a safe place until performance time.

Auburn Students.

Auburn students who purchase tickets online in advance – your tickets will be available for pick-up during rehearsal at the Kent Studio or to be picked up during theatre rehearsals or the day of performance.

Rehearsals

Costumes are to be worn to ALL rehearsals.

Saturday June 1st thru Wednesday June 12 are scheduled for rehearsals at the Kent Studio.

These rehearsals are held in place of regular class schedule.
See the rehearsal calendar for days and times.

Please Note: Rehearsals for Auburn students are held at the Kent Studio.

Rehearsals on June 14th Friday, 16th Sunday, 17th Monday & 18th Tuesday are at the Highline Performing Arts Center (No rehearsal Saturday June 15th)

located at 401 S 152nd St in Burien.

It is important to remember that at these on stage rehearsals, students are performance ready.

This is where we encourage parents to take their photos and videos.

If any student is missing any part of their costume, they will not be permitted onstage.

Students should arrive fully dressed in costume and have hair appropriately styled.

Those in more than one part, have other costumes in their garment bag and clearly identified. Please mark all costume pieces, shoes, tights, etc. with the student's name.

Please remove all jewelry, earrings, bracelets that are not part of the costume.

BRING NOTHING EXTRA, THEY ARE OFTEN LOST.

Please be punctual and we ask parents to drop students off as scheduled, leave and return when the rehearsal is completed.

While at the Performing Arts Center, students need to be in their assigned seating area where they can be accounted for and chaperoned by a parent volunteer.

Attendance at all rehearsals is vital for a successful performance. If a student misses 2 or more rehearsals between Saturday June 1st and Tuesday June 18th, they will be removed from their part and be replaced with an understudy.

Parking

Park 184 Studio in Kent: there is plenty of space behind the buildings. Carpools are great!

At the Highline Performing Arts Center please park in designated areas only.

- We have attendants at the theatre to assist you.
- You will not be allowed to park in fire zones or in the circle drive in front of the theater.
- Please do not leave anything of value in your vehicle.
- The British Dancing Academy and The Highline Performing Arts Center are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Costumes

Costumes and accessories will be available for pick up during the month of May. A schedule of distribution times will be posted at the studios.

All outstanding balances must be paid in full for costumes to be distributed.
including the final tuition payment for May/June

Payments can be made:

- At the studio with check, cash or credit card.
- On line prior to pick up.
- If paying by check and sending through the mail, it must be received and processed by the office before you can pick up costumes.

At the time of pick up, we will go through each costume with you and make sure all pieces are included. If a student comes to rehearsal or performance missing an accessory, it will be a \$20 replacement fee.

Tights and shoe ribbons are available at the studio

Now you have the costume...

THIS IS HOW IT WORKS:

- Students arrive in costume starting Saturday June 1st
- Students with a costume change will be provided a garment bag for their change
- On the front of the bag -BIG & CLEAR - print student's name, part and cast
- Students need to decorate their bag for easy identification and to reflect what's inside
- Now put everything for that part in the bag (start at the bottom and work up... shoes, tights, costume, headpiece, gloves, etc)
- Students name in shoes and every item.
- Then parents discourage students from taking anything out of the bag without your supervision **AND** always double check after each rehearsal. Is it all there?

NO GUM OR MESSY FOOD WHILE IN COSTUME!

Video Recording and Photography

There is Absolutely NO photography or recording of any kind Allowed during the performances.

Parents are allowed to take photos and videos during the Dress Rehearsals at the Highline Performing Arts Center June 9th 10th & 11th

- We allow video recording and flash photography only to be done from the designated area behind the director's station.
- You will need to use power pack for video recording as there are no available power sources.
- ONLY PARENTS ARE ALLOWED
- Do not bring children or guests who are not members of the cast.

on PERFORMANCE DAY

- Students arrive at a special time in order for our team to prepare hair and makeup before the performance. Please come with clean face and hair, Thank you.
- Remove all jewelry, earrings, nail polish, tattoos, ink and anything that is not part of the costume.
- Parents will bring students to the entrance of the theatre where our helpers will escort them to the dressing/ waiting room.
- Please don't allow students to bring I-pods, electronics, extra clothing, back packs or anything extra that will most likely be lost or left behind.

DOORS OPEN 1 HOUR BEFORE PERFORMANCE

There is **no reserved seating**. The only saved seats are for the volunteers who helped backstage prior to the performance.

The show is estimated to run 2-½ hours. Evening performances -Thursday, Friday and Saturday end at 9:30 - Saturday Matinee ends at 3:30 – Sunday the final performance ends at 7:30.

After the performance students will be dismissed from the stage after the final curtain call.

Parents Please Note:

For security reasons, students CANNOT be contacted during the performance nor will they be allowed to leave prior to the end of the show.

NOTE TO GRADUATING SENIORS AND THEIR PARENTS

Following the final performance on June 23rd, **parents of our graduating seniors** may present their flowers to their child on stage. Please be ready to approach the stage immediately following the last bow. It is a special evening for our seniors which includes our awards ceremony, but it is a late evening for our youngest students. We appreciate you presenting flowers without hesitation.

BDA CODE OF CONDUCT

In order to maintain a safe and professional environment, we have established a code of behavior which is enforced during all rehearsals and performances. These rules are for the safety and well-being of all cast members.

- Students are expected to be courteous and to follow the directions of teachers and designated chaperones.
- Students must stay in their assigned areas where they will be chaperoned at all times.
- Students are not allowed to leave during a performance
- Students are required to be quiet backstage
- Students are not allowed cell phones onstage or backstage

If these rules are not followed, the student will receive one warning. Thereafter, they will be removed from the cast.

It is our privilege to perform at this superb facility. We are guests and will act accordingly.

Do not stand, put feet on seats or the back of seats.

No food, drinks or gum in the theatre.

(If you bring food for your child during rehearsal, it must be eaten in the lobby.)

No Photos or recording of any kind during the performance
